Financial Report: MaryAnn Oram gave a report on the current budget. There has not been an official budget voted on for the current school year. MaryAnn created a temporary budget using past years as a guideline.

Admin Report:

Mr. Fowler introduced Senate Bill 38. This bill has passed the Utah Senate and will be brought before the House of Representatives. This bill will increase the amount of local replacement funds that charter schools are paid for their students. Mr. Fowler asked for volunteers to contact Representatives to give support.
