**Welcome & Introductions:** Syd Snow introduced the new Executive Board and Academy Reps.

**Financial Report:** MaryAnn Oram distributed the Booster Club Budget for 2014/2015. The current bank balance is \$2,172.57. A discussion was held regarding funds for the academies. In prior years the funds have not been distributed evenly between academies, some academies have not received funds. It was discussed if funds should be given equally to each academy, or if it should be on an as-needed basis. It was decided the Academy Reps would discuss their needs with the Advisors and the issue would be readdressed at the next Booster Club Meeting.

**Admin Report:**

- Principal Weeks reported that Tuacahn has great new staff and students. Please give feedback to her on the new teachers. She reminded us that if there is an issue with a teacher, first communication should always be with the teacher, admin should be advised only if there is not a satisfactory resolution with the teacher.
- Principal Weeks informed the Booster Club that last year there was a donor who gave \$20,000 to the school to help with scholarships for trips, school fees etc. This year no such donation has been made. This will limit what the school is able to scholarship for students.
- Tuacahn has a need for tools and equipment for the new art studio.
- The new Driver's Ed Car will be here soon.

**Vote on Canopy Purchase:** Syd Snow addressed the issue of the broken canopy the Booster club owns. This is used for several events, including selling the Lehi Roller Mills products at the Saturday Market. Julie Fonseca made a motion to purchase a new canopy up to \$300, Jenni Heiner seconded the motion. The motion passed.
