MINUTES

Meeting was called to order at 7:05pm.

Treasurer: MaryAnn Oram presented the current budget.

Academics: Principal Weeks has hired two academic coaches to assist students who need help. Several new Concurrent Enrollment classes may be added for the next school year.

Instrumental Music: A search is underway for an instrumental music teacher. Jason Bonham will be leaving at the end of the school year.

Tech Theatre: Syd Snow reported that the Tech department is in need of masks and rubber gloves.

Committee Reports:
