TRAVEL POLICIES

- Adherence to Policies and Procedures:
 - All participating students will be required to adhere to established school policies and procedures
- Participation in Activities:
 - All attendees are required to participate in each activity listed on the daily agenda. No deviations
 to the schedule will be made by students without the approval of their advisor(s). Participants are
 expected to respect the time and effort of others by being on time and actively participating in all
 scheduled activities.
- Use of Drugs and/or Alcohol:
 - The use of drugs and/or alcohol is strictly forbidden according to the policies of Tuacahn High School for the Performing Arts. This includes prescription and non-prescription drugs. If you require any prescription medication, it must be listed above. Use of drugs and/or alcohol will result in immediate dismissal from the activity with further disciplinary action as noted in the Parent/Student Handbook.
